For all types of visas, please ensure that

1. You have pasted one recent color photograph (Photo specifications differ and must be checked on our website)
2. You have attached your Current Valid passport with a minimum validity of 190 days and 2 blank/unstamped pages.
In case of Canadian Passport, ensure that you have signed page three of the Passport.
3. You have signed your application form.

(If admission is not confirmed, provisional admission letter may also be produced). 2. <p>Entry visa/Conference visa/Volunteer Visa / Research visa/ Journalist visa</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A letter of invitation from the organizers of the Conference/Volunteering institute. 2. Approval, if any, obtained by the organizers from the Government of India for holding the Conference or the registration of the organization arranging voluntary work. 3. For Journalist visa, a letter of accreditation from the media group. (For documentary filming in India, the media crew may seek prior approval before applying for Journalist visa. <p>Business Visa</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A letter from the applicant's company /organization in Canada. 2. An invitation letter from India indicating the nature of applicant's business, duration of stay, the places and firms to be visited in India. 3. <p>Employment Visa:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Copy of the Employment Contract. 2. Proof of registration/incorporation of the company with the Government of India. 3. Letter on employer's Letterhead indicating nature of job, salary structure and duration of contract. 4. For Teaching jobs, Letter of appointment from the school and no-objection from the Ministry of Human Resources and Development, New Delhi. 5.
